In some cases, the "artistic ego" does not let him accept the forced separation, despite being aware of the clauses of the contract he signed with his client. #### **ABSTRACT**

Introduction: Oral problems may involve not only physical health, but also economic aspects and social and psychological well-being. They can even affect self-esteem, demonstrating the importance of maintaining oral health in quality of life Method: integrative literature review based on the following guiding question: what are the possible changes in the oral health of people with Down Syndrome (DS). A consultation was carried out in the LILACS and MEDLINE databases, with the descriptors in Portuguese, "oral health" and "down syndrome" and in English adopted "oral health" and "down syndrome". Articles published in the last five years (2016 to 2021) in Portuguese, English and Spanish and freely available in full were included in the study. Results: 7 articles were included that met the defined inclusion/exclusion criteria, 4 in LILACS and 3 in MEDLINE. Conclusion: it is necessary to carry out studies with better research designs and with adults and/or elderly people with DS, since most of the selected studies focused their research on children and/or adolescents with DS.

#### **ABSTRACT**

The study addresses the current situation of school management and how it has been managed in its dimensions, investigating whether the contributions of participatory management interfere with the learning of 3rd year students and other school segments in the municipality of Dias d'Ávila - Bahia. The quantitative/qualitative heterogeneous method used with a factual approach described in the period of six months of the second half of 2016. Data collection obtained through a semi-structured questionnaire, involving ten questions, analyzing the low IDEB indexes; high dropout rates and failure rates among students enrolled in Regular High School. In the analysis of the results, a set of managerial situations was identified which contributed to the facts that occurred. Conclusion from the point of view of the investigated actors detects a traditionalist management practice, impacting the results of the pedagogical praxis, its high rate of failures and abandonment. The research suggests the experiment of participatory management as an empirical method, the creation of a nucleus for monitoring graduates in educational units, seeking to strengthen the school institution and student learning. HEPATIC STEATOSIS AND PREVALENCE OF NCDS IN PATIENTS UNDERGOING BARIATRIC SURGERY IN A REFERENCE SERVICE IN SÃO LUÍS-MA

#### **ABSTRACT**

Bariatric surgery and lifestyle changes are an effective method to facilitate weight loss, in addition to improving comorbidities in obese patients. This study aims to correlate hepatic steatosis with the prevalence of NCDs in patients undergoing bariatric surgery. Cross-sectional study with consultation of the database of patients monitored by the Bariatric Surgery Service of the University Hospital of UFMA, with descriptive and analytical characteristics. Fifty-two patients with hepatic steatosis were evaluated, 92.3% female, with a mean age of 42±9.4 years and a mean BMI of 46±7.6Kg/m². Systemic Arterial Hypertension was the most prevalent (55.8%), followed by Diabetes mellitus (51.9%). It is concluded that hepatic steatosis is a risk factor for CNCDs. The study was able to achieve its objectives by correlating the prevalence of hepatic steatosis and its association with CNCD in preoperative bariatric surgery patients. The objective of this work was to give a lecture with an educational approach, carried out through a partnership between Municipal Health Surveillance and the São Joaquim State School for the prevention of dengue in the Municipality of Conceição do Mato Dentro. The lecture took place at the school during the month of March 2022 for about 300 elementary school students, where 40 students were evaluated and the data reported within this research. In the lecture, tools for mosquito identification, disease symptoms, prevention and measures to combat the vector were shared. #### **ABSTRACT**

Covid-19 originated in China, with a high transmission capacity made a rapid emergence of the pandemic. With everyone very concerned about knowing the virus and all its procedures, mental health was the least notoriety, causing many to have deficiencies in this area. The present study aims to describe the strategies used by individuals to overcome grief, discuss the psychosocial impacts of mourning Covid-19, therefore, the focus is always on mental health in relation to the grief experienced. This is an integrative literature review study. The analysis of the articles allows us to infer that there is a lack of coping strategies for pain and psychic suffering of the population in the face of grief, since few manage to reach the service having to resort to alternative methods, also having a great perception that the number of professionals eligible for this action are extremely low. Through this study, we hope to help more health professionals pay attention to the mistakes previously made during the pandemic and encourage changes in the quality of care provided to the grieving population, not only during a pandemic, but at all times of mourning.
